

## How to get to Exeter

Exeter is easy to travel to by coach or train, and also has its own international airport. On arrival in Exeter, students will be met by their host. A Globe staff member will meet groups.

We can provide a taxi transfer and private coach transfer booking service. We are also happy to book public transport on behalf of our clients. If they prefer to make their own arrangements, below are our recommendations. Coaches are generally cheaper.

### Unaccompanied minors:

Many airlines require children under 14 to be checked-in at the airport by an adult. Please check the airline's regulations relating to 'unaccompanied minors' for young students. Please note that for taxi transfers, there is a supplement of £40 each way for unaccompanied minors.

### Meet and Greet Service

from £70 at Heathrow airport; recommended for children under 16 travelling alone. Other airports are available. No separate meeting service is necessary for taxi transfers or Globe Minibus Service.
