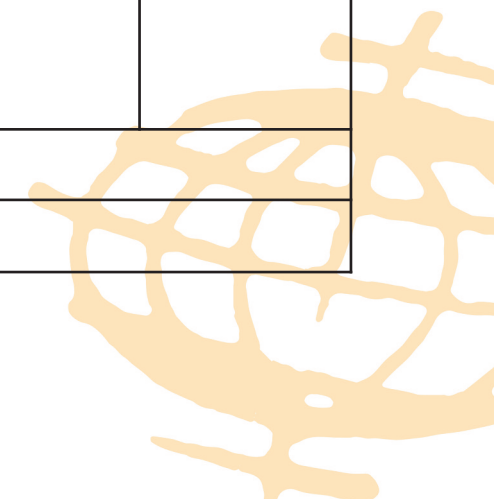

An Intensive Programme for CAE

Course Facts:

- 🕒 21 hours of exam preparation classes per week, for Cambridge Advanced
- 🕒 Social programme including a mid-week afternoon excursion, a Saturday excursion and 1 social evening per week.
- 🕒 Course length: Choice of 4 week, 6 week, or 8 week course
- 🕒 Start Dates: July 5th, July 19th, Aug 2nd 2026
- 🕒 Class size: Maximum 12
- 🕒 All course materials and social programme included

Course Info

- 🕒 An intensive CAE exam programme including grammar revision, vocabulary development, and exam techniques for all papers.
- 🕒 Using a variety of published materials and past papers, students will cover all aspects of the exam.
- 🕒 Familiarity with the exam is helpful but not essential.
- 🕒 Prior to enrolment, all students will be required to take an online grammar test and attend a short interview (via Zoom) to assess their level.
- 🕒 Students will have the opportunity to mix with students on other courses as the social programme is for all students in the adult school.

- 🕒 Students have the option of taking the exam in the UK
- 🕒 Friday 28 August in Bristol
- 🕒 Exam fee: £240
